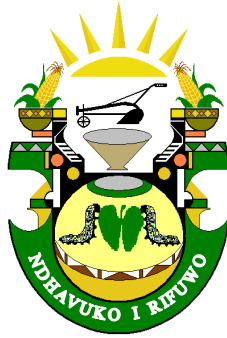

ACTIVITIES TO CLOSE MANDELA MONTH

July has been declared Nelson Mandela Month the world over in recognition of the former states man whose birthday is the 18th July. To keep Nelson Mandela's positive legacy going, the Greater Giyani Municipality Mayor Councillor Pat Hlungwani handed over a house to a needy destitute woman at Kheyi village on the 18th July 2014. This, in addition to cleaning activities that took place at Siyandhani, Shawela, Dzumeri and Nkomo B.

Now the Municipality, as led by the Mayor has set aside the 30th of July to round off Mandela month activities by dedicating 67 minutes doing routine cleaning targeting Kremetart suburb in Giyani. Starting from Monday the 28th July 2014 leading to the 30th July 2014, the municipality deployed a high number of its machinery and employees to clear all the rubbles around the suburb. The work will culminate with the high deployment of officials, all councillors and stakeholders spread throughout the suburb.

In addition the Mayor has made a clarion call to all members of the community including business people around Giyani Town to also take some time and clean their yards and the surrounding areas.

People will assemble at Kremetart opposite Xisaka Guest house at 09h00 where the Mayor will briefly address them before dispersing to various working points.
